STEP 4

The Inward Journey

For me, fear and false pride were everywhere! My fear held me hostage and my false pride kept me in denial.

Knowing the real me as the result of a thorough inventory has given me the gift of becoming "right sized". Whenever I think I have the right to judge others, I remember my own defects of character! I then put the thought into my mind immediately that I am not qualified to judge anyone! I am not Divine! Not only did my inventory show me my erroneous actions, it also showed me my correct actions. I now had a way better idea of what to never repeat and what to do more often. I began to feel comfortable in my own skin. Fake monster became a real human!

To satisfy the decision made at last month's Intergroup meeting to bring our Prudent Reserve up to 15%, \$3,452.80 was transferred out of checking into savings. Additionally, some of January's expenses, including payroll, were recorded in February and have been included in this month's report.

Current available funds for operating expenses total \$61,988.84 which is equal to 5.39 months of operating expenses. We have also established a savings account holding our prudent reserve of \$20,705.68, which equals 15% of our annual budget.
