Step 2

Belief In A Possibility

I was told, for step two to work, all I had to do was have willingness to be willing to attempt something different. I figured I had nothing to lose because my way was not working! I was not sure about the Higher Power thing yet. I was willing to keep myself open to the possibility that there was something powerful enough to restore me back to physical, mental, and spiritual health. I was too badly mangled from following my own thoughts to protest new ideas. I love that Herbert Spencer quote cited in the appendix about the spiritual experience in the back of the Big Book which basically states that if I want to stay ignorant, have contempt prior to investigation. For me, this means I will keep suffering if I stubbornly close my mind off to ways that just might work better than mine! I have always been proud of my intellect so when I read that, I knew it would be foolish of me not to "run the Alcoholics Anonymous experiment" and note any results. I was also guided to look around myself and notice those powerful forces at work that do not originate from me. For example, nature's seasonal cycles and waking up every morning to warm sunlight. Even more tangible examples than nature were observing those individuals in recovery around me who have been restored to wholeness of being as a result of their connection to the Divine. I heard story after story of hopeless alcoholics, like myself, being not only restored to health but also transformed into their highest potential as individuals! The evidence I gathered was overwhelming proof that there is something way bigger than me at work! The biggest reward I received as I practiced this step was the gift of feeling genuine hope for the very first time in my life!

Brief discussion on Central Office/Intergroup income. We did operate at a loss for 2024. No budget items were over on spending, our income just simply did not match expenses. We will need more contributions from groups and individuals to achieve a balanced budget in 2025.

PI/CPC (Jim H. - CPC, Kathi S. - PI) No report- did not meet in December because of holiday. Next meeting Jan. 22nd.

Treatment (Courtney B.) No report.

Grapevine (Open at time of report) Great turnout at Alcothons- \$428 in sales of literature. New Area 03 Grapevine Coordinator is Gabriel. Ruby nominated by committee for new Chair.

Events (Dave D.) Christmas brought in \$6,706.68 for a net income of \$2577. NYE brought in \$2759.90 for a net income of \$309. Note that these incomes cannot be included in the 2024 YTD profit. Setting up an Ad Hoc committee to review potential new location for Founder's Day and Alcothons.

Historian (Patrick F.) Has met once so far in new rotation; trying to get organized! Meeting has moved to 2nd Sunday at Central Office.

Homebound Outreach (Open)

Area Liaison/Vice Chair (Eileen B.) Eileen will be serving for the second year of Pat S.'s rotation. District 11 meeting location has changed to Central Office. Sub District 11-119 now meets on the second Monday of the month. 11-114 not meets at Eastside Meeting Place. District 11 has voted on how to distribute the excess funds of \$9,875.46: \$2000 will be allocated to Intergroup committees to purchase literature from Central Office, \$1500 has gone to Area 03, \$3,187.73 has gone to GSB, and \$3,187.72 has gone to the Grapevine Carry the Message Project. Sub District 11-114 is holding a Home Group Appreciation Lunch and speaker meeting on finances at St. Paul's United Methodist on February 8th. Eileen will be attending all Area assemblies and PRAASA, as well as the International Conference.

2025 Budget: Presented to the body with numbers for budget items and the needed projected contributions/income for a balanced budget. Committee chairs were given the opportunity to consult on their budgets. Motion to accept the budget made by Ted G., seconded by Kelly: 2025 budget approved by the body. Ted M. will look into the payroll tax increase from the past 2 years to see if we are paying the correct amount.

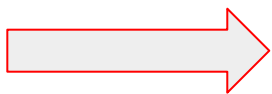

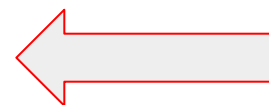

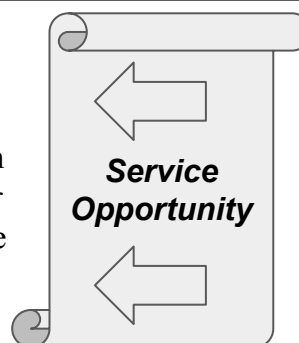
