## STEP 8

### Am I Willing Yet?

I have learned that in order for me to accurately inventory the harm I have caused to others, I must first become willing to remove that thought of being victimized by them. For me, I had to examine my level of willingness to do this for each individual. I was taught a technique that has been very helpful for me to shift my focus to myself and my own harmful actions. For each being on my list, I wrote the things I know I have done wrong and in a contemplative way I asked myself if I was willing to do whatever this person asked of me to correct my wrongs. If my answer was yes, I made a note of it. If my answer was no, I noted that also and then I asked my Higher Power for help. If I was not quite sure I recalled all the ways I caused harm to someone or if I was unclear if my deeds were even harmful, that was when I asked my Higher Power for guidance and clarity. I also considered if others were involved who could end up getting unnecessarily harmed or if this individual would be harmed further by my mere presence. In these cases, I have discussed each with my sponsor for the best course to take and I then asked my Higher Power to show me when to proceed. I also asked myself how free and serene do I want to be and how willing was I to do my part in this equivalent exchange? Staying in a victim mindset, for me, has only perpetuated my selfishness and my own suffering. By picking up the tool of willingness to hold myself accountable for my harmful behavior, I have released myself and everyone else from bondage.
